**NEW BUSINESS:**

**1. Need for New Commissioners:**

**§ 154-2. Board of Commissioners.**

A. There is created, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:12-1 et seq. a Board of Park and Recreation Commissioners of the Borough consisting of seven members. The members shall be appointed by the Mayor, with the advice and consent of the Council. There may be one member of the Council on the Board of Park and Recreation Commissioners, who shall be appointed annually by the Mayor, with the advice and consent of the Council, for a term of one year. All of the members of the Board shall be citizens and residents of the Borough.

B. The Commissioners first appointed shall be appointed for terms of one, two, three, four and five years, respectively, and the additional Commissioners shall be appointed one for four and one for five years. Thereafter, all appointments shall be for the term of five years, and vacancies shall be filled for the unexpired term only. The members shall serve until their respective successors are appointed and shall qualify.
